- 1. Walls 'N All-EFP Bathroom Cleaner
- 2. Fast-1-2-3 EFP Cold Water Detergent
- 3. Liquid or Aerosol Window Cleaner
- 4. Crème Cleanser
- 5. Maid Cart with Mop Bucket & Wringer
- 6. **Primo-Pro**[™] Wet Mop
- 7. Toilet Paper, Hand Towels, Toilet Seat Covers Polyliners and any special trash liners
- 8. Work Gloves & Goggles

- 9. Wash, Rinse, & Drying Cloths
- 10. Clean and dry general cloths
- 11. Toilet Bowl Swab & Caddy
- 12. Detail Scrub Brush & General Brush
- 13. Floor Broom & Dust Pan with Brush
- 14. "**Restroom Closed**" Door Sign Insert
- 15. "Wet Floor" A-Frames or Cones
- 16. Special tools or items for job

Upon Arriving, Check Following...

Note and report issues beyond your scope of work

- 1. Lighting and electrical equipment. Electrical odors.
- 2. Dripping faucets, poorly running water in urinals, etc.
- 3. Clogged toilets, Urinals, or sinks.
- 4. All Paper & Hand Soap levels.
- 5. Paper and Liquid dispenser functionality.
- 6. Source of any offensive lingering odors.
- 7. Water minerals, soap scum, & mildew buildup.
- 8. Hand dryer(s) functioning correctly.

Moving Forward With Cleaning...

- 1. Flush urinals and toilets where needed.
- 2. Replenish hand soap and paper supplies.
- 3. Sweep floors & empty trash.
- 4. Wash sinks, mirrors, counters, & soiled touch areas.
- 5. Wash urinals & Toilets.
- Wet mop floor using TQH-Certified detergent. Use cold water & make sure floor drains receive solution.
